K&N[®] Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N[®] cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N[®] cabin air filter.

Before you begin, note the position of the firefighter tag. (Fig. 1) The firefighter tag must be visible and accessible once the installation is complete.

- 1. Open the front trunk and remove the rear panel. (Fig. 1)
- 2. Locate the cabin filter housing on the passenger side.
- 3. Remove the cabin filter housing door by squeezing the tabs on each side. (Fig. 2, 3)
- 4. Remove the dirty cabin air filter from the housing. Clean any debris that might be present inside the housing. (Fig. 4)
- 5. Install the K&N® cabin air filter. (Fig. 5)
- 6. Reverse steps 1 and 3 to complete the cabin filter installation. With the K&N[®] cabin filter installed, clean an area and apply the K&N[®] Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter. NOTE: The firefighter tag must be visible and accessible for firefighters as shown on figure 1
