K&N<sup>®</sup> Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

## When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filter.

- 1. Open the hood and locate the cowl cover on the passenger side. Fig. 1
- 2. Remove the seal from the cowl cover & pull the harness mount out of the cover. Figs 2 & 3
- 3. Squeeze the tabs on the front of the cowl cover and lift to remove it. Fig 4
- 4. Pull the tab on the front of the cabin filter cover and remove it. Fig 5
- 5. Unclip the 4 tabs to remove the cabin filter tray with the two dirty filters. Clean out any debris in the housing. Figs 6 & 7
- 6. Install one new K&N<sup>®</sup> filter in the housing with the thick end towards the front of the car. Snap in the tray and install the second filter in the same direction. Figs 8 & 9
- 7. Reverse steps 1-4 to complete the installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area near the filter door and apply the K&N<sup>®</sup> Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a re-usable cabin filter.


