

Note: Refer to the instructions included with your impact bumper brackets for removal of the OEM bumper.

With the OEM bumper removed, remove the parking sensor wiring harness and the two center parking sensor bezels from the plastic bumper cover. The outer two sensors will remain in their factory locations.

Step 2

Insert two plastic expansion nuts into the sensor relocation plate. With the impact bumper installed on the vehicle, insert the relocation plate through the access hole on the bottom of the bumper and secure with two self-tapping screws.

Note: Install the relocation plates into the center two holes of the impact bumper. The outer two holes will not be used.





Step 3

Route the wiring harness through the access hole in the back of the impact bumper. Install the parking sensor bezels into the relocation plates and reinstall the parking sensors into their bezels.

Check that all connections are tight and use the provided cable ties to secure the wiring harness.
