

MBRP Muffler Installation Instructions



Note: Local regulations may limit or prohibit modification to your snowmobile's emissions system and/or the sound levels that it generates. It is your responsibility to be aware of restrictions that may apply to your intended use of this product.

- 1. Seat Removal:
 - a. Remove bolts fastening seat(2x10mm)
 - b. Lift seat off machine
- 2. Remove rear plastic cover over the stock muffler tip.(4x5mm Allen bolts)
- 3. Cut stock exhaust pipe using a reciprocating saw (Sawzall) or hack saw 7.25" forward from the stock muffler location. (See Pictures)







- 5. Place band clamp on MBRP muffler front pipe and install the front hanger off the stock muffler onto the MBRP muffler.
- 6. Apply a thin layer of high heat silicone to both the inside of the MBRP muffler and outside of the remaining stock exhaust pipe.
- 7. From rear of sled slide MBRP muffler in to place, ensure the MBRP muffler hangers are mounted through the rear brackets.
- 8. Reconnect the front hanger (2x10mm)
- 9. Tighten band clamp over slip joint
- 10. Reinstall rear plastic exhaust cover and bolt seat back on to sled.

To avoid exhaust leaks use high heat silicone to seal all connections between expansion chambers and muffler. Monitor for leaks during the first 200 miles after your installation and re-apply silicone where necessary. We suggest having your local snowmobile mechanic or performance shop install this product.

CAUTION: **<u>DO NOT</u>** touch muffler while snowmobile is running or shortly after it has run, as it may result in personal injury.
