

Note: Local regulations may limit or prohibit modification to your snowmobile's emissions system and/or the sound levels that it generates. It is your responsibility to be aware of restrictions that may apply to your intended use of this product.

- 1. Remove the side panel to access the stock muffler.
- 2. Remove the two springs attaching the muffler to the tuned exhaust pipe. (Set these springs safely aside so that they can be reused.)
- 3. Remove the spring further up the tuned exhaust pipe to allow the pipe to move freely.
- 4. Remove the spring on the backside of the stock muffler.
- 5. Remove the stock muffler from the belly pan. Be careful not to damage the gasket at the muffler inlet.
- 6. Remove the rubber bushing from the upper bracket of the stock muffler and transfer it onto the MBRP muffler.
- 7. Install the MBRP muffler in the same location as the original muffler and re-attach all springs to the spring tabs.

CAUTION: **<u>DO NOT</u>** touch the muffler while the snowmobile is running or shortly after it has run, as it may result in personal injury.
