


Fabric Replacement Top Installation Instructions

For: Suzuki Samurai

Part Number: 51133

This Pavement Ends Soft Top requires all factory original equipment hardware to complete the installation. Note: If you are missing the tension straps and related mounting hardware, please refer to page 2 of these installation instructions.



WARNING

This product is designed to enhance the appearance of the vehicle and to shield the occupants from ordinary weather conditions. Do not rely in any way on the components of this product to contain occupants within the vehicle, or to protect against injury or death in the event of an accident. This top will not protect the occupants from falling objects. Never operate vehicle in excess of manufacturer's specifications.

WEAR SEAT BELTS AT ALL TIMES

Read and follow, precisely, all installation instructions provided when installing top. Failure to do so may result in a poor fitting top and could place occupants of the vehicle in a potentially dangerous situation. After installing or reinstalling the top, check to make sure it has been properly installed.

Installation Tips

Before you begin installing this top assembly, read all instructions thoroughly. After completing the installation, keep these instructions for future reference. Below are a few tips to make this installation easier.

For a smooth fit:


For ease in installation, the top should be installed at temperatures above 72° F. Below this temperature, the fabric may contract an inch or more, making it difficult to fit to the vehicle.

It is normal for the fabric to contract and wrinkle when stored in the shipping carton. Within a few days after the installation, the fabric will relax and the wrinkles will disappear.




Step One

Orient the top with the two snaps toward the front of the vehicle. Drape it over the vehicle. Open the hook and loop flaps over the doors. Snap the front snaps to the vehicle. Center the plastic strip and slip only the plastic into the channel along the top of the windshield.




Step Two

Drape the top over the rear bow. Slide the front edges of the side panels into the channel on the rear of the Sport Bar.




If the Tension Straps and/or Hardware are missing from your top, call 877-638-9509 to order replacement parts. Follow these steps to install.



Replace Missing Studs


If the Studs are missing from the bow on your vehicle, install the Body Studs included with your top. Center the rear seam on the bow and use the snap flap as a guide to mark the locations of the snaps. Center punch and drill a 3/32 inch hole for each stud. Install the studs with a #6 Sheet Metal Screw.



Replace Missing Tension Straps

If the Tension Straps are missing from your vehicle, install the straps included with your top. Center punch and drill a 7/32 inch hole on each side of the tailgate, above the existing bolt. Install each Tension Strap with a #10-24 x 3/4" Truss Head Phillips Screw and a #10-24 Locknut. Install the Tension Strap with the hook and loop fasteners facing the outside of the vehicle.



Step Six


Snap the snaps on the bottom of the side panels from front to back.

Fasten the bottom of the Rear Curtain to the Lift-A-Dots on the rear of the vehicle.




Step Seven

Wrap flaps around door frames and attach hook strips to loop strips.



Wrap flap around door frame and fasten hook and loop




Adjusting the Top

Rear Curtain

To roll up the Rear Curtain, start at the bottom and roll it to the inside. Avoid wrinkles in the fabric and window. Secure it in place with the curtain straps inside of the top.

WARNING: When operating the vehicle with the rear window open, one or more door windows should be open for proper ventilation.

Care and Maintenance of your New Top

Your top is made of the finest materials available. To keep it looking new and for the maximum possible wear, it will need periodic cleaning and maintenance.

Washing: The fabric should be washed often using soap, warm water and a soft bristle brush. Rinse with clear water to remove all traces of soap.

Zippers: Keeping the zipper cleaned and Normal Slider lubricated with a silicone Jaws Parallel lubricant will help prevent damage and keep the zippers Damaged Slider in a smooth working condition. Jaws Spread Apart (sometimes broken) If a zipper opens behind the slider, the slider may have been spread apart. This problem can usually be repaired by using an ordinary pair of pliers to bring the sides back into parallel. Return slider to the end of the zipper in the normal Open position. Squeeze lightly at first and test the zipper. If the zipper continues to remain open squeeze more firmly with the pliers and try the zipper again. Repeat this procedure until the zipper operates correctly.

Water: In the event of seeping through the seams, 3M Scotchgard® may be applied on the inside of the seams to stop the seepage. Rips in the fabric may be repaired with Bondex®

iron on patches. Iron the patches to the Inside of the top, carefully following the Bondex® instructions.

Snaps: Keep snaps cleaned and lubricated with silicone to help prevent snaps from sticking to the studs. If a snap does become stuck to a stud, use a screwdriver and GENTLY pry apart to prevent permanent damage to the snap or the top fabric.

LIMITED WARRANTY

We warrant our product to be free from defects in material and workmanship, for the terms specified below, provided there has been normal use and proper maintenance. This warranty applies to the original purchaser only. All remedies under this warranty are limited to the repair or replacement of any item or items found by the factory to be defective within the time period specified.

If you have a warranty claim, first you must call our factory at the number below for instructions. You must retain proof of purchase and submit a copy with any items returned for warranty work. Upon completion of warranty work, if any, we will return the repaired or replaced item or items to you freight prepaid. Damage to our products caused by accidents, fire, vandalism, negligence, misinstallation, misuse, Acts of God, or by defective parts not manufactured by us, is not covered under this warranty.

THE WARRANTY TIME PERIOD IS AS FOLLOWS: ALL "SOFT GOODS" MANUFACTURED BY OUR COMPANY (USING PRIMARILY VINYLS, PLASTICS, AND/OR FOAM): ONE YEAR FROM DATE OF PURCHASE.

ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND/OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE CREATED HEREBY ARE LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE SAME DURATION AND SCOPE AS THE EXPRESS WRITTEN WARRANTY. OUR COMPANY SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGE.
