2-REAR SHOCK BRACKET 1-POLY BAG CONTAINING: 2-12MM X 65MM BOLTS 2-12MM FLANGE LOCKNUTS 2-5/16" X 3/4" BOLTS 2-5/16" LOCKNUTS 2-CRUSH SLEEVES 4-FLAT WASHERS

TOOLS NEEDED

13mm Socket / Wrench 15mm Socket / Wrench 18mm Socket / Wrench



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. After the shock has been removed from the lower mount, install the lower shock bracket as shown in Photo 1 with the supplied 12mm x 65mm bolts, flange locknuts with supplied crush sleeve. Do not tighten at this time.
- 2. Install the 5/16" x 3/4" bolts, washers & nuts as shown in **Photo 2**. Tighten using a 13mm socket / wrench.



Install 12mm x 65mm hardware & crush sleeve

- 3. Tighten the 12mm bolts using a 18mm wrench & 18mm socket.
- 4. Install the shock absorbers on the new bracket with the supplied flat washers as shown in Photo 3 on both sides of the shock and secure with the factory hardware. Tighten using a 18mm wrench and 15mm socket. Stock Shocks Shown in picture.



Install 5/16" x 3/4" Hardware



POST INSTALLATION

- 1. Check all fasteners for proper torque. Check to ensure there is adequate clearance between all rotating, mobile, fixed and heated members. Check steering for interference and proper working order.
- 2. Re torque all fasteners after 500 miles. Visually inspect components and re torque fasteners during routine vehicle service.
