




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Jack up the front of the vehicle and place on jack stands. Remove the front wheels.
- 2. Remove the ABS wire bracket from the upper control arm using a 10mm socket/wrench. See Photo 1.
- 3. Remove the nut from the upper control arm at the knuckle using a 18mm socket/wrench. See Photo 2. NOTE: Strike the knuckle with a hammer to release the upper control arm.






- 4. Remove the nut from the tie rod end at the knuckle using a 21mm socket/wrench. See Photo 3.
- Remove the bolts from the lower strut using a 15mm socket/wrench. See Photo 4.






- 6. Remove the nuts from the upper strut using a 18mm wrench. See Photo 5.
- 7. Remove the ABS wire bracket from the middle of the knuckle using a 10mm socket/wrench. See Photo 6.








- 8. Remove the ABS wire from the lower knuckle using a 10mm socket/wrench. **See Photo 7**.
- 9. Remove the ABS wire bracket from the upper knuckle using a 10mm socket/wrench. See Photo 8.







- 10. Remove the sway bar link nut from the lower control arm using a 18mm socket/wrench. See Photo 9.
- 11. Drop the lower control arm down and remove the strut from the vehicle. See Photo 10.





- 12. Remove the stock upper control arms using two 21mm sockets/wrenches. See Photo 11.
- 13. Install the RC upper control arm using the stock hardware. See Photo 12.





- 14. Reassemble suspension in reverse order of tear down.
- 15. Grease ball joints. NOTE: Re-grease during regular maintenance checks.
- 16. Put on wheels and lower.

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
