INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS

- 1. Installation shown on a Jeep XJ Cherokee but will fit other 5x7 headlight applications. Refer to those corresponding manuals for those vehicles to install. On the XJ Jeep remove the (4) screws from the outer head light trim panel using a Phillips bit driver. Retain screws for later use. **See Photo 1.**
- 2. Remove the outer head light trim panel. See Photo 2.





- 3. Locate and remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the head light into the head light bezel. See Photo 3.
- 4. Remove the head light and disconnect the plug from the wiring harness. See Photo 4.





- 5. Determine which headlight plug will be needed for installation and connect it to the vehicles wiring harness. **See Photo 5.** H4 and H13 adapter harnesses are included with this kit.
- 6. Install the new head light in to the head light bezel. Then apply the OE trim ring around the head light and secure using the retained screws. **See Photo 6.**





7. Confirm the head lights are properly wired in and work properly.



- 8. Install the head light trim panel and secure using the retained screws. Tighten using a Phillips bit driver. **See Photos 7 and 8.**
- 9. Check the height and the alignment of the lights. Perform this in a dark room with the front of the vehicle facing 25





feet away from a wall or flat surface with the lights on the low setting. See Photo 9. Adjust as necessary.
