

Installation Instructions JK Billet Fuel Door Part#75007 07-16 JK 2+4 door

Do not ingest magnets. If ingested, immediately seek medical attention.

Step 1: Remove OE/factory fuel cap, this will be re-used.

Step2: Remove the two right hand screws that attach the driver side taillight. Then push the light towards the passenger side and remove light. Disconnect wires or place taillight in safe location such as the bumper.

Step 3: The OE fuel cover is held in with plastic clips(4). Gently pry the clip tabs inwards to allow it to release from the vehicle. It is helpful to gently pull on the fuel cover from the outside. The two rear most clips should be easy to get to, the front two may be difficult to release, if so, gently work the fuel cover out. You may use a small pick or screwdriver to release the front clips

Step 4: You will notice a small hole on the body of your jeep where a pin on the fuel cover will fit into. Your new billet fuel door base will have 2 pins. You will remove one for your application. 2 door and 4 door vehicles have different pin locations, 4 door uses the pin in the 9 o'clock position. Remove the one that does not line up with your application. Do not worry if both pins are accidently removed. The fuel door base will still stay securely attached to vehicle without them. Make sure the pin you remove is cut flush with the flat mounting surface.

Step 5: Remove gas cap lanyard and filler tube gasket from OE fuel cover. Reinstall filler tube gasket and gas cap lanyard on billet fuel door housing.

Step 6: Make sure pin is lined up with pin hole and slide filler tube into gasket, then push fuel door base onto the body till all 4 plastic clips are engaged and secure. If you find that the clips are not securing , you may gently press on them with a screwdriver to help seat them.

Step 7: Attach billet cover to base using the provided screws. Light duty thread locker is recommended. Make sure all 6 bolts are snug. Do not over tighten.

Step 8: Re-install tail light. Do not over tighten taillight hardware.
