Step 1

Begin by removing factory grille assembly from vehicle. Refer to vehicles owner manual for proper front grille disassembly. Carefully place the grille face up on a soft surface. Remove the lower grille by unscrewing the two factory Philips head screws located along the top of the lower grille. (Fig 1)



Step 2

Position the X-Metal Grille into the center of the factory grille shell. While supporting the X-Metal Grille assembly, flip the entire assembly face down exposing the back of the grille. Install the two 135° flange brackets and nylock nuts in the two exposed studs located on opposite sides of the grille securing the flange brackets to the factory grille opening. (Fig 2)

Step 3

Secure the tabs to the grille with the included 6-32 Nylock nuts. The 135 Degree tabs will secure the X-Metal grille to the assembly as shown. Reinstall factory grille assembly in reverse order of assembly. Your installation is now completed. (Fig 3)
