


Figure 2: Remove Automatic Locking Hubs.





Figure 3: Remove Automatic Locking Hubs.



Preparation:

- 1. Turn the ignition key OFF. Put transmission in Park (automatic) or Reverse (manual).
- 2. Set the parking brake and block the rear wheels.

Removing Manual Hubs:

Remove the Tinnerman Clips that are securing the hublock assembly to the wheel studs. See figure 1. Remove the hublock assembly from the hub and rotor assembly.

Removing Automatic Hubs:

If you are replacing automatic locking hubs you will also need to replace the wheel bearing adjusting nuts. Your local Ford dealer can supply the adjusting nuts and washers for use with manual locking hubs. Warn Industries offers spindle nut conversion kits specifically designed to replace the wheel bearing adjusting nuts and work with manual locking hubs. Warn's Spindle Nut Conversion Kits are:

1983 through very early 1990 vehicles with 23 tooth axle spline..........Warn P/N 27988 Early 1990 and later vehicles with 27 tooth axle spline............Warn P/N 32720

- 1. Remove the Tinnerman Clips that are securing the hublock assembly to the wheel studs. See figure 1.
- 2. Remove the hublock assembly from the hub and rotor assembly.
- 3. Remove the axle shaft retaining ring, splined steel thrustwasher, needle thrust bearing (on earlier vehicles), and steel thrustwasher.
- 4. Remove the cam assembly, thrust spacer and thrust bearing or thrust washers from the wheel bearing adjusting nut. See figure 2 and 3.
- 5. Remove the single or double hump locking key from the wheel bearing adjusting nut. Use a small pick to locate and extract the locking key. Note: Be sure the adjusting nut is not binding against the locking key. Any binding may make removal of the key very difficult.
- 6. Remove the wheel bearing adjusting nut.

Installing Manual Locking Hubs:

- 1. If replacing automatic locking hubs with manual locking hubs reinstall the axle shaft splined steel washer or needle thrust bearing and the axle retaining ring.
- 2. Install the Hublock assembly against the wheel hub and rotor.
- 3. Install the wheel and tire and torque the lug nuts to 85 to 135 ft-lb.

MANUAL HUB OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

2WD Operation:

Set both control dials at "FREE" and the transfer case selector at 2WD for free wheeling two wheel drive. Use the "FREE" position for all driving that does not require four wheel traction.

4WD Operation:

To engage four wheel drive, set both hub control dials at "LOCK" move the transfer case selector to 4WD. Do not drive on hard surface roads in this mode. It can result in severe torque wind-up in the gear-train. Return the transfer case to 2WD before unlocking the hubs.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS



CAUTION



Do not move the vehicle if the control dials are anywhere between "FREE" and "LOCK". To do so may cause hub damage.

Do not move the vehicle with only one hub engaged. To do so can cause damage to the front differential.

Do not move the vehicle with the hubs in the "FREE" position and the transfer case in low range. To do so may damage the rear drive train.

Engage both hub locks and drive for a minimum of one mile each month to insure lubrication of the front axle.

Attach your name, address, telephone number, a description of the problem, and a copy of your receipt and original bill of sale of the defective hub and date of purchase.

This warranty does not apply (i) to finish, or (ii) if the hub has been damaged by accident, abuse, misuse, collision, overloading, modification, misapplication, improper installation, or improper service. Commercial or industrial use or application voids the warranty.
