

As you read these instructions, you will see **NOTES**, **CAUTIONS** and **WARNINGS**. Each message has a specific purpose. **NOTES** are additional information to help you complete a procedure. **CAUTIONS** are safety messages that indicate a potentially hazardous situation which, if not avoided, may result in minor or moderate injury. A **CAUTION** may also be used to alert against unsafe practice or possible equipment damage. **WARNINGS** are safety messages that indicate a potentially hazardous situation, which, if not avoided could result in serious injury. **CAUTIONS** and **WARNINGS** identify the hazard, indicate how to avoid the hazard, and advise of the probable consequence of not avoiding the hazard. **PLEASE WORK SAFELY**!


- Read the Winch Operator's Manual, ATV Operator's Manual, and all warning labels before operating the winch and ATV.
- Stay clear of moving parts and cable. Keep others away when operating the winch.
- Inspect the winch mechanism, fasteners, and cable, before operating. Replace all worn or damaged parts before operating.
- Make sure the winch is deactivated when leaving the ATV unattended.



INSTRUCTIONS:


STEP 1: Remove the rear storage compartment and the two rear side reflectors. Be sure to keep the reflectors intact, as you will be reapplying them after the kit has been installed. (Note: not all bikes have storage compartments)



STEP 2: Drill out holes with a 5/16" drill bit as needed to clear any excess paint and/or weld debris.



STEP 3: Install mounting plate using the 5/16"-18 bolts and lock nuts provided. After installation, re-attache refectors to the sides of the mounting kit.



STEP 5: Place the winch on the mounting kit as shown below, secure with bolts provided with winch.
