V. INSTALLATION

1. The mounting brackets bolt to the side tubes located on the frame, Figure 1.



2. Loosely fasten the mounting brackets to the side tubes using the 1/4-20 x 1.125" x 1.75" u-bolts, flat washers, and lock nuts, Figure 2. Do not tighten the bolts at this time.



3. Place the backing plate under the bumper tab, Figure 3.



INSTALLATION CONT.

4. Position the bumper so that it rests on top of the front exposed tube, Figure 4.

ACAUTION The bumper can slip off of the front tube at this point. Do not let go of the bumper until it has been properly secured, see step 5.



5. Loosely fasten the backing plate and bumper tab to the tube with the 1/4- 20×1.5 " x 2.25" u-bolts, flat washers, and lock nuts, Figure 5. Do not tighten the bolts at this time.

6. Loosely fasten the lower bumper tabs to the mounting brackets with the supplied $5/16-18 \times 1$ " bolts, flat washers, and lock nuts, Figure 6.



INSTALLATION CONT.

7. Position the bumper so that it is centered on the ATV and there is a space between the stock plastic pieces and the bumper, Figure 7. Tighten all fasteners at this time to the recommended torque specifications found on page 2.

8. The bumper is now fully installed, Figure 8. See page 6 for instructions on mounting accessory trail lights.

PROCEED TO SECTION TITLED "MAINTENANCE/CARE".

9. This bumper is equipped with holes for mounting accessory trail lights, Figure 9. The trail light brackets can be mounted to the bottom of the center section of the bumper.

VI. MAINTENANCE/CARE

1. Inspect all parts on the bumper and related hardware prior to each use. Replace all hardware that appears rusted or deformed.
