

- Ratchet	1/4	8 lb. ft. (10.8 N-m)
- 7/16" Deep Socket	5/16	17 lb. ft. (12.5 N-m)
- 1/2" Socket	3/8	30 lb. ft. (40.7 N-m)
- 7/16" Wrench	7/16	50 lb. ft. (67.8 N-m)
- 1/2 Wrench	1/2	75 lb. ft. (101.7 N-m)

V. INSTALLATION

1. The mounting bracket bolts to the side tubes located on the frame, Figure 1.

2. Loosely fasten the mounting bracket to the side tubes using the 1/4-20 x 1.125" x 1.75" u-bolts, flat washers, and lock nuts, Figure 2. Make sure that the recessed edge is toward the front of the vehicle. Tighten the bolts just enough to allow a little side to side movement in the bracket.

3. Loosely fasten the center frame bracket to the underside of the bumper before you install the bumper for ease in placement.

INSTALLATION CONT.

4. Slide bumper into position making sure the previous installed bracket slides in over the lower frame work as you are lining up the tabs as shown in Figure 4.

5. Loosely fasten the lower bumper tabs to the mounting brackets with the supplied 5/16-18x1" bolts, flat washers, and lock nuts, Figure 5.

6. Install u-bolt to center bracket shown in Figure 4 to frame of vehicle. Tighten the u-bolt at this time as it will help position the bumper to the vehicle shown in Figure 6.

INSTALLATION CONT.

7. Allow for about a 1/8 of an inch clearance between the top flange of the bumper and the plastic shown in Figure 7.

Tighten the 5/16 bolts located in the side tabs at this time as shown in Figure 5.

Tighten the center bracket to the front flange of the bumper at this time. Tighten the remaining bolts at this time.

8. The bumper is now fully installed, Figure 8. See page 6 for instructions on mounting accessory trail lights.

9. This bumper is equipped with holes for mounting accessory trail lights, Figure 7. The trail light brackets can be mounted to the bottom of the center section of the bumper, Figure 9.

PROCEED TO SECTION TITLED "MAINTENANCE/CARE".

VI. MAINTENANCE/CARE

1. Inspect all parts on the bumper and related hardware prior to each use. Replace all hardware that appears rusted or deformed.
