



- STEP 1. Remove the contents from box and check for damage. Verify all parts are present. Read instructions completely before beginning.
- STEP 2. Attach light guard assemblies as shown. **SEE FIGURE 1.**
- STEP 3. From underside of vehicle and behind bumper, remove four 8mm bolts and three 6mm bolts that secure the plastic shroud.
- Determine passenger and driver brackets. Remove tow hooks using a 15mm socket. **SEE FIGURE 2.**NOTE: Vehicles without tow hooks, attach mounting brackets to frame using 1/2" fasteners. Install bolts through existing holes in "L" Bracket on the side of the frame. **SEE FIGURE 2.**
- STEP 5. Position bracket between vehicle frame and tow hook and attach using existing tow hook bolts. Hand tighten.
- STEP 6. With Sportsman lying front side down in front of vehicle, align lower bracket slot and Sportsman slot. Fasten using 1/2" fasteners on each side. Hand tighten. Rotate Sportsman up slowly toward vehicle until remaining slots in bracket and Sportsman line-up. Fasten together using remaining 1/2" hardware. Hand tighten.
- STEP 7. Center and level Sportsman with vehicle. Torque tow hook bolts to 75 Ft. Lbs and 1/2" bolts to 65 Ft. Lbs.
- STEP 8. Reinstall plastic shroud previously removed. Torque 8MM bolts to 87 ln. Lbs. and 6MM Bolts to 36 ln. Lbs.



Finish protection - Westin products have a high quality finish that must be cared for like any other exposed finish on the vehicle. Protect the finish with a non-abrasive automotive wax (pure carnauba, for example) on a regular basis. The use of cleaner wax or any compound which contains an abrasive is detrimental, as the compounds scratch the finish and open it to corrosion.
