


PROCEDURE


1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. NOTE: It will be necessary to remove the front license plate and bracket. If local/state laws requires a license plate, license plate relocation kit 32-0055 is available.
- 3. Position brackets onto bottom surface of frame using 3/8" yellow zinc fasteners. Leave loose. SEE FIGURES 2 AND 3.
- 4. Attach support brace to brackets using 3/8" stainless steel fasteners. Attach support brace to frame using M12 fasteners. Leave loose. SEE FIGURE 3.
- 5. Attach Bull Bar to mount brackets using 1/2" fasteners. Level and adjust Bull Bar as desired and tighten all fasteners. SEE FIGURE 4. Recommended torque values are 37 Ft. Lbs. for 1/2" fasteners, 17 Ft. Lbs. for 3/8" stainless steel fasteners, 26 Ft.Lbs. for 3/8" yellow zinc fasteners and 55 Ft. Lbs. for M12 fasteners.
- 6. LIGHT INSTALLATION: Insert threaded stud on base of the light through hole in cross tube. Using a ratchet, extension and socket for correct size of nut supplied, insert through large clearance hole in bottom of cross tube. Thread nut and washers on stud and tighten. SEE FIGURE 1. NOTE: A short socket, not a deep well works best to get the nut started.
- 7. NOTE: Fits most 6" round or rectangle lights. Some lights may require replacing included mount/isolator with rubber.










CARE INSTRUCTIONS

DRILLING:


