





PROCEDURE


Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.


- 2. Begin by trimming roof rubber strips to expose mounting holes. Locate the front mounting location by measuring from the front of the rubber strip to approximately 7 1/4 inches and make a cut. Leave approximately 5 1/4 inch gap and make another cut. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Locate the rear mounting location by measuring from the back of the rubber strip where it meets the window to approximately 11 1/4 inches and make a cut. Leave a 5 1/4 inch gap and make another cut. See **Figure 2** for reference.






4. Starting on the driver side, use the provided M6 hardware (**items 16,18, and 19**) to loosely secure the Driver Side Front Rail Support Bracket (**item 6**) and Driver Side Rear Rail Support Bracket (**item 8**) to the mounting holes from steps 2 and 3. <u>Note:</u> Use provided foam gaskets and spacers under each bracket. See Figure 3 and 4.






5. Insert (4) M6 Slide Nuts (item 15) into the Driver Side Rack Rail (item 1). See Figures 5-7.









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
- 6. Loosely attach the Driver Side Rock Rail (item 1) to the Driver Side Front Rail Support Bracket (item 6), Driver Side Rear Rail Support Bracket (item 8), and (2) Cros Rail Brackets (item 10) using provided M6 Slide Nuts (item 15) and M6 hardware (items 17-19). See Figure 8.
- 7. Repeat steps 4-6 on the passenger side using (items 2, 7, and 9).




- 8. Install (2) Cross Rail Brackets (item 10) and the Driver Side Rear Cross Rail Bracket (item 11) on the Driver Side Rack Rail using the M6 hardware (items 15, 17-19). See Figure 9.
- 9. Repeat step 8 on the passenger side using items 10 and 12.




- 10. Locate 5 Cross Bar Rails (item 3) and insert (1) M6 Slide Nut (item 15) into the slots on each side and place them on the Cross Rail Brackets (items 10-12). See Figure 10.
- 11. Loosely secure the Cross Bar Rails to the Cross Rail Brackets using the M6 hardware (items 17-19). See Figure 10.



- 12. Align and loosely secure the Visor (item 4) to the Driver and Passenger Side Rack Rails (items 1 and 2) using the M6 hardware (items 15, 17-19). On each side, insert (2) M6 Slide Nuts (item 15) into the upper surface and (2) M6 Slide Nuts into the outer surface. See Figure 11.
- 13. Loosely secure the Visor Cover (item 5) to the Visor using the M6 hardware (items 17-20). See Figure 12. Note: If lights are used, the Visor cover will not be needed.
- 14. Once everything is adjusted to their desired locations, tighten all M6 hardware to 7 ft-lbs.


