





PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

2. Loosely assemble the Anti Rattle Bracket (2) to the Step Bar (1) using the supplied M8 hardware. *Note:* Use either set of the three holes as needed for your application. **See Figure 1-2.**





- 3. Slide the step bar into the receiver hitch of your vehicle. Lock it into place with the receiver pin (not included).
- 4. Install the M10 bolts (7) into the Anti Rattle bracket. Snug up the bolts until the whole assembly is tight and does not move excessively. *Note:* Do not over tighten bolts, this is only to keep the assembly from rattling on the vehicle. See Figure 3.
- 5. Adjust bracket accordingly and torque down all installed M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs.








CARE INSTRUCTIONS
