



PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Start installation on driver's side. On the rocker panel find locations with open holes and insert in the top open holes (2) M8 nut clips (Item 25). NOTE: ON SOME VEHICLES THE MOUNTING HOLES DO NOT LINE UP FROM THE FACTORY IF THIS IS THE CASE DRILL OUT THE HOLES USING A 7/16" DRILL BIT
- 3. Then loosely install M8 hardware to previously installed Nut Clip; (2) M8 hex head bolts, (2) M8 flat washers, (2) M8 split lock washers. For installing to bottom open holes of the rocker panel, loosely install, (2) M8 button head bolts, (4) M8 flat washers, (2) M8 split lock washers, (2) M8 hex nuts. Repeat the same procedure for all other mounting locations. See Figure 1.
- 4. Note: For 2010 up model years place (1) front mounting bracket spacer (Item 14) in between the rocker panel and the front mounting bracket before installing. See Figure 2








- Locate the supplied M12 bolt plate (item 15) and M12 fish wire (item 31), and guide the bolt plate through the specified holes on the bed rail located underneath the truck closest to the front of the bed. See Figure 3
- 6. Once bolt plates are through the specified holes locate the top isolator bracket (item 9). Loosely install the bracket with supplied M12 hardware. See Figure 4
- Continue by locating the isolator kit (item 11) and the isolator bracket (item 9). Loosely install the brackets with the supplied M12 hardware. See Figure 5



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







- 8. Obtain both sections of the Step Bar Assembly (1 or 2). Slide the Reinforcement Links (6 & 7) into both sides of the step bar sections. **See Figure 6.**
- 9. Line up the holes on the Step Bar sections with the holes on the Reinforcement Links (6 & 7). See Figure 7.









10. Place the supplied step pad (3) into the holes to connect the two Step Bar sections (1 & 2). Place the supplied thread cutting nut on each of the plastic stems. Tighten until nut reaches metal and feels firm in place. See Figures 8 & 9.






11. Obtain the Link Plate (5) and secure it to the Step Bar Assembly (1 & 2) using the supplied black M6 Hardware. **See Figure 10.**






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
- 12. Installation of the step boards will utilize the supplied black M8 hardware with Plate Adapters (12) for all brackets excluding the Link Brackets (4). The Link Brackets (4) will use the supplied black M10 hardware. **See Figures 11 & 12.**
- 13. Align and adjust the step bars and brackets as needed, then fully tighten all hardware: M8 to 15-18 ft-lbs, M10 to 32-38 ft-lbs, and M12 to 52-60 ft-lbs.



Plastic Cover Installation:


1. Locate (1) plastic bracket cover (Item 13) and loosely secure it to the brackets using the provided hardware: (2) M6 hex head cap screws, (4) M6 flat washers, and (2) M6 nylock nuts. Repeat for every bracket. See **Figure 13**.


