PROCEDURE


- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Start installation by moving both front seats to their furthest front location to expose rectangular bar. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove both rear passenger handles by removing (2) plastic caps to expose the (2) bolts underneath. Remove the bolts to remove both handles. See **Figures 2 and 3**.










- 4. Starting on either side, locate (1) clamp bracket (Item 4) and (1) mount bracket (Item 5/6). Loosely secure onto the rectangular bar underneath the seat using the supplied M10 hardware (Items 16-18). See **Figures 4 and 5**. Repeat for other side.
- 5. Locate partition assembly (Item 1) and with assistance carefully insert into vehicle. Loosely secure onto the previously installed mount brackets (Items 5 and 6) using the provided M12 hex head serrated flange bolt (Item 19). See **Figure 6.**









- 6. Loosen air bag side relief plastics and attach upper mount brackets (items 7 and 8) using hardware 13, 14 and 15. Between frame and air bag side relief plastics. See figure 7 and 8. Leave them loose at this time.
- 7. Loosely secure the upper mount brackets (Items 7 and 8) onto the vehicle where the handles were removed using the provided M6 hardware (Items 10 12). See **Figure 7**.
- 8. Tighten the hardware near the upper mount bracket (Item 7/8) on the partition assembly (Item 1). Tighten the hardware near the upper mount bracket, air bag relief plastic, and air bag relief bracket onto the partition assembly. See **Figure 6**.






Locate the flat or recessed panel (Item 9) (see note below) and loosely secure onto the partition assembly using the supplied hardware: (10) M6 flange hex nuts (Item 20). Then locate the driver/passenger side foot pockets (Items 2 and 3) and loosely secure onto the partition and middle cover plate or recessed panel using the supplied hardware: (2) M6 short button head bolt (Item 21), (14) M6 flange hex nuts, and (2) M6 flat washer (Item 12). See **Figure 9**. **Note:** Use M6 flange nuts (Item 20) to install accessories plates on Recessed Panel or flat panel. **Figure 10**. Use small plate if electrical channel is installed.





- 9. Loosen the seat rail screws in the rear of the front seats. Remove the far in one, and save it. It will be reuse.
- 10. Install straps items 22 and 23 under the rail as shown in figure 11. First hole of the strap is for the rail pin. Use the screw previously removed from the rail to attach the strap. Attach the other side of the strap to the partition using a M6 Flange nut (20).
- 11. Align and adjust the partition assembly and then tighten hardware to: M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs, M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs, M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs, and M10 hardware to 30-35 ft-lbs.




CARE INSTRUCTIONS
