





PROCEDURE


1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.




- 2. Remove the five lower clips found under the front end of the bumper. See Fig. 1
- 3. Carefully remove the front bumper cover by pulling from the bottom up. See Fig. 2








- 4. With the now exposed bumper plate, unbolt the bumper. See Fig. 3
- 5. Unplug any connections to the bumper. See Fig. 4
- 6. Remove the bumper.




- 7. Remove factory bolt and install upper support strap with previously removed factory bolt. See Fig. 5
 - A. Measure the distance between the upper brackets. Make sure it is 33 1/4 inches. See Fig. 6
 - B. Torque the factory bolts to 16 ft lbs.
 - C. Re-install the factory bumper and the bumper cover in the reverse order that was previously instructed.





8. If tow hooks are equipped, remove the tow hooks. *Note: Factory Tow hooks will not be reused.* See **Fig. 7.** If tow hooks are not equipped use a cutting tool to cut out the plastic where the tow hook opening would be.




9. Once tow hooks are removed, cut the lower valence so that the lower mount bracket can slide through. *Note: for vehicles without tow hooks, the tow hook pocket area and the valence will have to be cut.* See **Fig. 8**



10. Slide double nut plate through frame and align with the two holes on the bottom of the frame. See Fig. 9

11. Once the double nut plate is aligned with the holes loosely mount the lower mount bracket with the supplied M12 hardware. See Fig. 10







12. Once the lower mount bracket is loosely mounted grab a M12 bolt plate and a M12 fish wire. Feed the fish wire through the hole in the frame with the threaded wire going in first. Once the fish wire is out on the open end of the frame, thread the M12 bolt plate to the M12 fish wire. Once sufficiently threaded pull the bolt plate through the hole in the frame. See **Fig.** 11

13. Once the bolt plate is through the hole, thread a retainer clip on the bolt plate so it doesn't fall into the frame. See Fig. 12


14. Repeat steps 12 and 13 similarly for the bolt plate that goes though the lower mount bracket. See Fig. 12




- 15. Grab the lower support bracket and loosely mount to the lower mount bracket using the supplied M12 hardware. See **Fig.** 13
- 16. Set the Winch Tray (1) on top of the lower mount brackets.
- 17. Loosely install the Winch Tray using the supplied black M12 Hardware. See Fig. 14.
- 18. Adjust the Winch Tray and torque down all hardware to specified ft-lbs: M12 to 60 ft-lbs.







WINCH TRAY INSTALLATION END

- 19. Loosely mount the grille guard to the previously installed winch tray and upper support bracket using supplied M10 and M12 hardware. **See Fig. 15 & 16.**
- 20. Adjust grille guard and torque down all bolts as specified: M8 to 16 ft lbs, M10 to 30 ft lbs, M12 to 55 ft lbs.










CARE INSTRUCTIONS
