



#### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
  - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Begin by opening the hood of the vehicle and removing the radiator cover. *Note:* There are 4 bolts holding the top of the grille to the radiator support that must be removed. See **Figure 1.**
- 3. Use a set of pliers to release the clips securing the grille to the vehicle. See **Figure 2.** Remove the grille.





- 4. Remove the bolts securing the inner fender to the bumper. See Figure 3.
- 5. Remove the side support bolts shown in **Figure 4.** *Note: The bolts have thread locker and will be difficult to remove.*







- 6. Unplug the fog lights (if equipped) from each side of the bumper. See **Figure 5.**
- 7. Remove the factory bolts on the top of the frame. These are located behind the grille that was removed in **Step 3**. See **Figure 6.** Also remove the two bolts on the side of the frame shown in **Figure 7**. Carefully remove the front bumper.







- 8. Remove the tow hook bolts and tow hook from each side of the frame. See **Figure 7.** *Note: Tow hooks cannot be reused.*
- 9. Insert the supplied M12 Stud Plate (7) into the bottom hole on each side of the frame. See **Figure 8.**







- 10. Loosely install the Mount Brackets (2,3) to the frame using the supplied M12 Hardware. See Figures 9 & 10.
- 11. Reinstall the grille as removed in **Step 3.**







- 12. If reusing the factory fog lights, remove them from the OEM Bumper by pinching the plastic tabs on the mounting points. If aftermarket lights will be used, install them at this time and move to **Step 14**.
- 13. Install the fog light brackets (4-6) as shown in **Figure 11** using the supplied M8 Hardware. Press the OEM fog light into place. *Note:* When installing OEM fog lights, use the supplied M10 Washers (14) to help retain the plastic clips on the light. See **Figure 12.**






- 14. With help, carefully lift the Bumper Assembly (1) into place. *Note: It will help to use jack stands or other supports to hold the bumper in place.*
- 15. Loosely attach the Bumper Assembly (1) to the Mounting Brackets (2,3) using the supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figures** 13 & 14.





- 16. Install the two license plate grommets as shown in Figure 15.
- 17. Trim the inner fender as desired. See **Figure 16.**
- 18. Align and adjust the bumper as necessary. Once the desired fit is achieved, torque all hardware as specified.
- 19. Torque M8 Hardware to 14 ft-lbs, M12 to 60 ft-lbs.




