




## **PROCEDURE**


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
  - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove the license plate and bracket. On models with factory fog lights, unplug both lights. On models with bumper mounted sensors, unplug all sensors. Release the wiring harnesses from the clips attached to the back of the bumper and move all wiring harnesses away from bumper.
- 3. Open the hood and remove the plastic cover on top of the radiator, See **Figures 1 & 2**. Temporarily remove the plastic grille.







**Note:** There are several inaccessible clips that provide some retention on the grille. They will pop loose when you pull on the grille near the clip location.

- 4. Release the rubber air deflector from the back of the bumper, if equipped, and remove it from vehicle. Next, remove the hardware at each end of the bumper attaching the bumper supports to each side of the frame, See **Figure 3**.
- 5. Place blocks or jack stands under the front bumper to support it during mounting bolt removal. Once the bumper has been safely supported, from above the bumper, remove the (2) factory bumper bolts from each side, See **Figure 4**. **WARNING!** Assistance is required to hold the bumper in place during bolt removal to prevent the bumper from falling. Carefully slide the bumper off of the end of the frame and over the tow hooks.






- **6.** Remove the factory bumper brackets from the ends of frame and remove both tow hooks (tow hooks will not be reused) See **Figure 5.**
- 7. Loosely install the Mount Brackets (2,3) using the factory hardware removed in **Step 6**. See **Figure 6**.







- Remove bumper brackets and tow hooks
- 8. Loosely install the Reinforcing Brackets (4,5) to the outside of the frame rail using the supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figure 7.**
- 9. If reusing the factory fog lights, install them at this time into the Bumper Assembly (1) using the supplied M10 Flat Washers (13). See **Figure 8.**







- 10. Install parking sensors into the Sensor Gasket (6) and position the holes concentrically on bumper and press with Sensor Tabs (8) against bumper plate. Loosely fasten Sensor Tabs with the supplied M6 hardware (14,15). **See Figures 9 & 10**. *Note*: Be sure to maintain the orientation of the sensor so that it remains consistent with its original orientation. Tighten M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs. *Note: Factory sensor grommets must be reused*.
- 11. If parking sensors will not be used, use the supplied Sensor Hole Plugs (7) to cover the sensor hole.






12. With help, lift the Bumper Assembly (1) into place between the Mount Brackets (2,3) and Reinforcing Brackets (4,5) and attach with supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figures 11 & 12. CAUTION:** The HDX Bandit Bumper is very heavy. The use of a floor jack or hoist is recommended.





- 13. Adjust and align the bumper as desired. Using a floor jack may be of help for this.
- 14. Torque all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft-lbs, M12 to 60 ft-lbs.
