



PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.






- 2. Unplug any wire connections to the OEM Bumper.
- 3. Open the hood and temporarily remove the top plastic cover between the radiator and the grille. See Figure 1.
- 4. Also remove the grille for easier access to top bumper bracket bolts by removing the (4) M6 bolts on the top of the radiator. See **Figure 2**. Remove the grill by carefully pulling on the grille near the attachment points. *Note: Using a pry tool to assist in releasing the clips may help.*






- 5. Release the clips attaching the lower splash guard to the back of the front bumper, (if equipped). Locate the factory bumper nuts attaching the outer bumper to the inner brackets and remove them. See **Figures 3 & 4.**
- 6. With assistance, remove the bumper assembly. Next, remove the (2) tow hooks. *Note: Tow hooks may not be re-used.*







7. Remove the driver side inner bumper bracket and lower frame extension brackets from the ends of the frame. See **Figure 5. NOTE**: Lower frame extension brackets cannot be reinstalled.

IMPORTANT: On models equipped with a diesel engine, the intercooler will need to be moved out of the way to remove the frame extension bracket. This is done by loosening the hose clamps & unbolting the intercooler brackets from the frame. Assistance is highly recommended to avoid damaging the intercooler.




- 8. Pre-install the factory bolt plates along with the supplied M12 Hardware into both frame ends. See Figure 6.
- 9. Loosely attach the Mounting Brackets (2) to the frame using the hardware from **Step 8** as well as the supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figure 7**.




- 10. Install parking sensors into the Sensor Retainer and position the holes concentrically on the bumper and press with Sensor Tabs (6) against bumper plate. Loosely fasten Sensor Tabs with the supplied M6 hardware (16,17). **See Figures 8 & 9**. *Note*: Be sure to maintain the orientation of the sensor so that it remains consistent with its original orientation. Tighten M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs. *Note: Factory sensor grommets must be reused.* Use the supplied Harness Extensions (3) as necessary.
- 11. If parking sensors will not be used, use the supplied Sensor Hole Plugs (5) to cover the sensor hole.








- 12. If reusing the factory fog lamps, install the Upper and Lower Fog Lamp Brackets (7-10) to the bumper using the supplied M8 Hardware, and insert the fog lamp into the fog lamp cutout, allowing the clips to seat in the three holes provided by the Fog Lamp Mounting Brackets. See **Figure 10.**
- 13. If installing aftermarket lights, use any of the three slots on the top portion of the fog lamp cutout to secure your aftermarket light. See **Figure 11.**



14. Loosely attach the Bumper Assembly (1) to the Mounting Brackets (2) using the supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figures 12 & 13. CAUTION:** The HDX Bandit Bumper is very heavy; use a floor jack to help support the bumper during installation.





- 15. Adjust and align the bumper as desired. Using a floor jack may be of help for this.
- 16. Torque all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft-lbs, M8 to 15 ft-lbs, M12 to 60 ft-lbs.
