




#### **PROCEDURE**

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Remove OEM bumper
  - a. Open the hood of the vehicle and remove the plastic cover at the front using a pry tool. See **Figure 1**.
  - b. Remove the four bolts holding the grill in place and uninstall the grill. See Figure 2.
  - c. Remove the braces on each side of the vehicle by removing the bolts indicated in Figure 3.
  - d. Disconnect all electrical connections to the stock bumper.
  - e. Remove the two bolts indicated in **Figure 4** on the driver's side of the vehicle. Repeat procedure on the passenger's side.
  - f. Remove bumper.













- 3. Using supplied M12 bolt plates and fish wire, pull the bolt plate through the inside of the frame. See Figure 5
- 4. Using Supplied M10 and M12 hardware, loosely install the main brackets, support brackets, and bracket A on both sides. (8-9). Note: The main bracket sides into the frame. The support brackets mount under the frame. **See Figure 6-8**













- 5. Using supplied M12 hardware, install the winch tray to the mounting brackets. Use the provided hole to access the inside of the brackets. **See Figure 9.**
- 6. Install your winch at this time following manufacturer's instructions.




- 7. If using sensors, install the optional sensor plates where the corner mesh covers are. (M6 hardware)
- 8. Remove the sensors from the stock bumper. Using the provided wire extension harness, install the supplied sensor retainer into each of the sensor plates from the front. Note: Ensure to install sensors in the same orientation you removed them. See Figure 10-12
- 9. If you are not installing sensors—Install mesh covers A and B using supplied M6 hardware. See Figure 13












- 10. If installing a light bar, install using the supplied LED light brackets and supplied M6 hardware, if applicable. Install light per manufacturers recommendation. **See Figure 14**
- 11. If you are not installing light bar, install the led light mesh cover using supplied M6 hardware. See Figure 15
- 12. If using light pods, install at this time.
- 13. Install a mesh covers to the bumper using supplied M6 hardware






- 14. Locate the main driver/passenger brackets. Re-using factory hardware, install the brackets on to the vehicle's frame. **Note leave snug enough to adjust for later.**
- 15. Measure the outer distance of the brackets. Make sure the distance matches the inner distance on the bumper mounting locations. (about 36 inches) See Figure 16




- 16. With help, install the bumper on to the main mounting brackets. Use the supplied M12 hardware. See Figure 16
- 17. Adjust as needed and torque all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft. lbs, M8 to 18 ft-lbs, M10 to 35 ft-lbs, M12 to 55-60 ft-lbs.





### CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
