






### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
  - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Open the hood of the vehicle and remove the plastic cover at the front using a pry tool. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove the four bolts holding the grille in place. See **Figure 2**.
- 4. Remove 2 bolts attaching wheel well cover to filler panel. See **Figure 3.**










- 5. Pry off fenders to access the filler panel clips. See **Figure 4.**
- 6. Pry filler panel off removing any necessary bolts. See Figure 5.
- 7. Disconnect any electrical plugs and any bolts still attaching the grill to the vehicle. See **Figure 6.**








- 9. Remove 4 upper bumper bolts attaching the bumper to the frame and remove 2 bottom bolts attaching bumper arm to the frame. See **Figure 7 & 8.**
- 10. Remove Bumper.






- 11. Once the bumper is removed, remove the sensors, sensor wiring harness, and the OEM fog lights. Remove the sensors carefully and make sure to pay attention to the sensor orientation since they must be reinstalled in that orientation. See **Figure 10 & 11**.
- 12. After you remove the sensors and harness, reinstall them on the new bumper. See **Figures 19** for a reference on routing the harness through the bumper and how to install the parking sensors.
  - 13. Remove OE bumper brackets and Aerodynamic Active Shutters carefully as they are fragile. **See Figure 9.**

Note: Removal of Aerodynamic Active shutters may cause Check Engine Light to turn on. Be sure to complete step 16.








- 14. Remove the factory tow hooks. See Figure 12.
- 15. Locate and install the Winch Tray Mounting Brackets loosely (5-6) with the provided M12 hardware (19-23). See **Figure 13 & 14** for reference. Repeat for passenger side.











- 16. Locate the OEM Aerodynamic Active Shutters and the Shutter Relocator Brackets (7-8) and install the shutters to the brackets with the provided M6 hardware (24-27). See **Figure 15 & 16** for reference. Adjust as needed.
- 17. Locate the Winch Tray (2) and install the Winch Tray onto the Winch Tray Brackets with the provided M12 hardware (19-23). See **Figure 16, 17, and 18** for reference. *Note: If you are installing a winch, do so now.*
- 18. Install all of the bumper accessories prior to installing the bumper onto the vehicle. See **Figure 18 & 19** for reference on installing the LED Center Brackets (14-15).
- 19. Reinstall the Parking Sensors if equipped in the same orientation that they were removed using the OEM parking sensor retainers. See **Figure 20** for reference. *Note: If parking sensors are not equipped you can use the Center and Outer mesh covers for the openings in the bumper.*



















- 20. Using the OEM hardware, install the Mounting Brackets (3-4) onto the vehicle. See Figure 21 for reference.
- 21. With help of a second person, install the Pro-Series Bumper onto the Mounting Brackets using the provided M12 hardware (19-22). See **Figure 22-23** for reference.





### 22. *Note*:

- Route the parking sensor harness carefully and secure it with zip ties.
- The HYPERQ LED Auxiliary Lights are sold separately. To install, use the provided hardware in the light kit.


