



PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove the three fasteners retaining the panel above the bumper from the inside of the wheel wells. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove the trim panel from the clips near the headlights. Use a pry tool if necessary. See Figure 2.





- 4. On both sides of the vehicle, use a pry tool to remove the fascia panel from the clips shown. See Figures 3 and 4.
- 5. Remove the fascia panel above the bumper. <u>Note:</u> The fascia panel contains plastic clips retaining it to the rest of the vehicle. Pull firmly and carefully on the fascia to remove it.







- 6. Open the hood and remove the lever seen in **Figure 5** using a T10 Torx driver. Remove the (2) screws and slide the lever toward the front of the vehicle.
- 7. Remove the plastic cover shown in **Figure 6**. Use a pry tool to disengage and remove the clips retaining the plastic cover.





- 8. Remove the fasteners retaining the grille. There are 4 fasteners along the top and three along the bottom. See **Figures 7** and 8.
- 9. Remove the grille from the clips above the headlights. See **Figure 8**.
- 10. Remove the grille by firmly and carefully pulling it away from the vehicle.






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11. Disconnect the electrical harness seen in **Figure 9**. If a block heater is equipped, disconnect the block heater cable.





12. Remove the panel shown in Figure 10. Lift the panel and remove the clips underneath see Figures 10 and 11.






- 13. Remove the (4) OE bolts located underneath the panel removed in the previous step. See Figure 12.
- 14. Remove the (4) OE bolts attached to the bottom of the plastic skid plate. See Figure 13.
- 15. Remove the (2) OE bolts on the sides of the bumper shown in Figure 13.
- 16. Remove Bumper by carefully pulling it out.






- 17. If an air baffle is equipped, remove the air baffle.
- 18. If tow hooks are equipped, remove the tow hooks.
- 19. Slide the Driver Winch Tray Bracket (item 3) into the frame. See Figure 14.




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
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- 20. Remove the OEM bracket from underneath the Driver Winch Tray Bracket. See Figure 15.
- 21. Loosely install the Driver Winch Tray Bracket and a Winch Tray Plate (item 5) using the M12 hardware (items 14, 16-20). See Figures 15 and 16.






- 22. Repeat steps19-21 on the passenger side.
- 23. Install the winch onto the winch tray. Use the Large M10 washers included with the bumper instead of the M10 washers included with the winch.
- 24. Loosely install the Winch Tray (item 2). Hold the Winch Tray between the Winch Tray Plates and beneath the vehicle frame. Use the M12 hardware (items 16, 18, and 19) to attach the Winch Tray to the Winch Tray Plates and Winch Tray Brackets. See Figure 17.



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
- 25. On each side, remove the M12 bolt directly above the Winch Tray Bracket.
- 26. Loosely install the Mount Brackets (items 3 and 4) on top of the Winch Tray Brackets using the M12 hardware (items 16, 18-20) and the M12 bolts removed in the previous step. See Figure 18.
- 27. Align and adjust the winch tray and brackets. Tighten and torque the M12 hardware to 55-60 ft-lbs.




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Parking Sensor Relocation Instructions If parking sensors are not equipped, skip to step 32.

28. Install the parking sensors to onto the Sensor Plates (items 9-11) using the Sensor L-Tabs (item 8), Double Sided Foam Tape Squares (items 26) and M6 hardware (items 23 and 25). See Figure 19.




- 29. Remove the small mesh covers from the Pro-Series Bumper. See Figure 20.
- 30. Install the Sensor Plates onto the Pro-Series Bumper using the hardware removed in the previous step. See Figure 20.
- 31. Tighten the M6 hardware to 5-8 ft-lb.





20" LED Light Bar Installation (B-Force Double Row LED Light Bar P.N. 09-12212-40C recommended) Skip to step 36 if you are not installing a LED light bar.

- 32. Remove large center mesh cover.
- 33. Install the LED Brackets (items 12 and 13) using the M6 hardware (items 22, 24, and 25). See Figure 21.
- 34. Install the LED light bar onto the LED Brackets using the hardware included with the LED light bar.
- 35. Tighten the M6 hardware to 5-8 ft-lb.



- 36. If installing LED light cubes (HyperQ LED Auxiliary Lights recommended), install them at this time. See Figure 22.
- 37. With help, install the bumper to the mounting brackets using the M12 hardware (items 16, 18, and 19). See Figure 22.
- 38. Align and adjust the bumper. Tighten and torque the M12 hardware to 55-60 ft-lbs.



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Parking Sensor Relocation Instructions If parking sensors are not equipped, skip to step 44.

- 39. Remove the wiring harness from the OEM bumper.
- 40. Connect the sensor cable extensions to the outer parking sensors.
- 41. Connect the wiring harness to the parking sensors and sensor cable extensions. Route the wiring harness over the mount brackets.
- 42. Connect the wiring harness to the vehicle. See Figure 23 for connection location.
- 43. Use zip ties to keep the wiring harness in place.




44. Reinstall the grille, fascia panel, cover, and lever. Refer to steps 2-12 for reference.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
