





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#### PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation. Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Unplug the OEM front bumper harness located on the driver side along with any other wiring to the bumper (sensors, fog lights, etc).
- 3. Remove the OEM front tow hook covers by removing the 5 allen bolts on each side shown with arrows in Figure 1 & 2.
- 4. Remove the frame mounted bolts from the locations shown. Then, carefully remove the OEM bumper. See Figure 3 for reference. *Note: Assistance for bumper removal may be needed.*








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- 5. Remove and unplug the OEM Active Cruise Control accessory since it <u>will not</u> be compatible with the Pro-Mod Bumper assembly. See **Figure 4** for reference.
- 6. Remove the OEM Active Cruise Control Harness from the vehicle. Be careful not to tear or pinch any wires. See Figure 5 for reference.







- 7. Locate and attach each Side Pod Assembly (Items 1 & 2) to the Center Section (Item 3) using the supplied M12 hardware (Items 20-22). See **Figure 6** for reference.
- 8. Tighten side pods in position now. Torque M12 hardware to 60 ft-lbs.
- 9. Use the supplied M6 Hardware to attach the LED Brackets (Item 11) to the center section. See **Figure 7.** *Note: If installing an LED Light Bar (sold separately), install it at this time according to manufacturers instructions.*.



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- 10. If the vehicle **is equipped** with parking sensors, begin to disassemble the OEM bumper completely by **removing all** of the hardware and bumper panels in order to gain access to the sensors and sensor harness.
- 11. Retain the OEM tow hooks as they will be reused on the Pro-Mod Bumper. See Figure 8 for reference.




### PARKING SENSOR INSTALLATION \*If not installing sensors, install Hole Plugs (Item 10) into holes on bumper and proceed.

- 12. Remove the parking sensors from the OEM bumper. Pay attention to the orientation of the sensors. They must be installed in the same orientation. Handle sensors with care, they are very delicate.
- Use the Sensor Tab (Item 9) along with the supplied M6 Hardware (Items 22-25) to install the sensors as shown in Figure 9.
  - Make sure to install using OEM rubber grommet and center the sensor in the holes. See Figure 10 for reference.

14. Carefully route the harness around the bumper.


Note: Zip ties or double sided tape can be used to route harness and to hold the sensor in position.








15. Locate and remove the OEM frame extensions. See Figure 11 & 12 for reference. 16. Loosely attach the preassembled bumper to the vehicle frame using the OEM Hardware. See Figure 13. Note: The OEM






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- 17. Locate and loosely install the Driver and Passenger Outrigger Base Brackets (Items 7 & 8) onto the vehicle frame using the OEM hardware from the previously removed frame extensions. See Figure 14 and 15 for reference.
- 18. Locate and loosely install the Driver and Passenger Mounting Brackets (Items 5 & 6) onto the Outrigger Base Brackets using the supplied M8 Hardware. See Figure 16 for reference.



19. Attach the Mesh Side Covers (Item 2) to the bumper using the supplied M6 Hardware (Items 12-14). See Figures 17 and 18 for reference.



20. Locate and install the Valence Skid Plate with the remaining M8 hardware (Items 15, 16, 17, & 19) as shown in **Figure 19**. 21. Align the bumper as desired and torque all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft-lbs, M8 to 18 ft-lbs, M12 to 60 ft-lbs.

#### CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.

## DRILLING:
