PROCEDURE


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
1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.


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
- 2. Begin by installing the Frame Brackets (2-3) to the Skid Plate (1) using the supplied M10 Hardware. See **Figure 1.**
- 3. Remove the two nuts on either side of the vehicle that fasten the factory tow hooks to the frame. See Figure 2.






- 4. Place the supplied U-Clips on the tabs of the Outlaw Bumper . See Figure 3
- 5. Position the Skid Plate so that the factory tow hook bolts line up with the slots in the Frame Brackets (2-3). Reattach the factory nuts. See **Figure 4.**






- 6. Use the supplied M8 Hardware to attach the skid plate assembly (1) to the Outlaw Bumper (sold separately). See **Figure 5.**
- 7. Tighten all hardware to spec: M10 to 40 ft-lbs, M8 to 20 ft-lbs.





CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
